Dr. Anika Wilson has been board certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology (ABPN) in General Psychiatry since 2008 and in Child & Adolescent Psychiatry since 2009. She completed her medical training at the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and then finished an internship in Pediatrics at the University of Alabama at Birmingham.

Dr. Wilson later pursued a combined residency and fellowship program in General Psychiatry and Child & Adolescent Psychiatry at UAB and completed them in 2007 and 2008, respectively. Dr. Wilson joined Alabama Psychiatric Services in September 2008 to 2015, with a practice focused primarily on the child and adolescent population.

In 2015, Dr. Wilson founded North Alabama Family Psychiatry, a private practice that services the psychiatric needs of children, adolescents, and adults. By 2016, this concept grew into the umbrella that is North Alabama Family Psychiatry & Counseling, offering psychiatric, psychological, and counseling services to the local community.

North Alabama Family Psychiatry & Counseling launched their NeuroStar Trans Cranial Magnetic Stimulation program in June of 2019.
